As part of our new system update, we've transitioned our specialty certifications to "legacy" status because we no longer offer them in our current certification programs. However, I want to assure you that this change does not diminish the value of your achievement. You still hold the certification because you earned it through your dedication and hard work, and that accomplishment remains a valid part of your professional qualifications.

In the new system, these certifications will now appear under "Past Certifications," in your portal, but this simply reflects the fact that they are no longer being offered to new candidates, not that they are any less significant.
